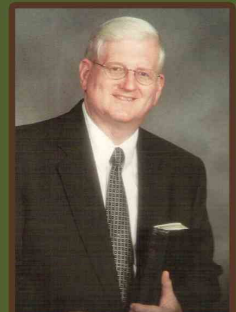
## Family Camp 2012 July 2 - 4 & July 5 - 6

**Bring:** Bible, pen, bedding, towels, wash cloths, personal items, clothes for evening rallies, water clothes, water shoes, high chairs & cribs.

**Dress:** In order to maintain modesty and consistency, we ask that you follow our dress code while at camp.

**Ladies:** Skirts that cover the knee and loose-fitting blouses or dresses for the evening services. Loose-fitting pants or loose-fitting, knee-length shorts or culottes may be worn for all other activities. No sleeveless tops. A one piece swimsuit under dark clothing for lake activities.

**Men:** Nice slacks and collared shirts required for evening services. Knee-length shorts or slacks/jeans may be worn for all other activities. No sleeveless shirts. Dark clothing for lake activities.

**Registration:** 10:00 - 11:00 am on the first day of camp (Monday or Thursday). Camp will conclude on Wednesday or Saturday at 4:00 pm.

**Program:** Some of the activities and sessions throughout the week will be age specific (nursery, junior, teen, and adult) while other activities will be designed for the entire family.

**Buildings:** At this point, we still do not have a Lodge on the property. We use a large "circus" tent for the dining room and the equipment shed for the meeting room.

## Information

**Utilities:** As of this writing, we still have not been approved to bring water, sewer, or electricity onto the property. It is likely that we will be using generators and porta-potties again this summer.

**Showers:** Making the likely assumption that we do not have our utilities installed, we plan to set up shower tents very similar to what we used this past summer. Each shower tent has three private stalls with hot and cold water. In addition, each shower tent has a sink for washing hands, brushing teeth, etc.

**SHCM Staff:** One or more staff members will be assigned to each family coming to family camp. The staff member can stay with your napping child, help in the food lines, or assist your family in any way possible. Our staff loves to serve you.

## Directions

### From Route 80 (traveling east) :

Take exit 111 (PA-153) and go south (right) on PA-153. Follow PA-153 about 23 miles to State Route 2011 (Atlantic Avenue). At this point PA-153 makes a turn to the left, but you should go straight onto Atlantic Avenue. Follow State Route 2011 (Atlantic Avenue) 2.4 miles to PA-53. Turn right and go 1.4 miles and turn left on PA-153. Turn left on Vulcan Road. Go 2.4 mile on Vulcan Street and continue straight onto Union Street (PA-453). Go 8/10 of a mile and turn left on Main St. (PA-253). Follow PA-253 about 4/10 of a mile and turn right on Railroad Street. Follow Railroad Street to sign.

### From Harrisburg :

Take 322 west to Exit 62 (Phillipsburg). Continue to follow 322 into Phillipsburg. In Phillipsburg you turn left on Route 53. In Phillipsburg you can take a five minute shortcut if you turn left on Route 504 (E. Presqueisle Street). Go about 6/10 of a mile and turn left on S. 4th Street. Take the 2nd right onto East Maple Street. Continue on PA-53 In Houtzdale go straight onto PA-253 (don't be confused by PA-153). Go straight onto PA -253 about 2.7 miles and make a sharp left on Beulah Street (staying on PA-253). Cross bridge and turn left on Railroad Street and go 200 yards to sign.

### From the South :

Take I-99 north and exit at 48 (PA-453 toward Tyrone) Follow PA-453 about 16 mile to Ramey. In Ramey go straight onto PA-253. Follow PA-253 about 4/10 of a mile and turn right on Railroad Street and go 200 yards to sign.
