

## Highlights of Staff Dress Code

- Sleeveless or tank tops should not be worn at any time
- Sunglasses should not be worn without special permission from the Director
- All fads and trendy styles should be avoided
- All staff will receive a Staff Polo Shirt and a team t-shirt to be worn at the specified times
- Shirts that use secular logos or thoughts replaced with Christian words are not allowed

## Staff Dress Code: Ladies

- All culottes must be loose fitting and must cover the knee when sitting.
- Skirts/dresses must be mid-calf or longer; and the slit cannot come above the bottom of your knee
- All garments must be loose fitting
- Slacks, shorts, or caprees may not be worn by Lady Staff Members.
- Dresses or skirts must be worn to all rallies; shoes or dress sandals (not flip-flops) must be worn to all rallies
- No baseball hats should be worn at anytime
- Jewelry should be limited to one small set of earrings, one necklace, and one ring (excluding wedding bands); no toe rings or thumb rings should be worn at anytime

## Staff Dress Code: Men

- Hairstyles must be off the ear and collar; bleached/dyed hair and shaved heads are not acceptable
- Collared shirts, dress slacks, socks (that cover the ankle) and shoes are required for all rallies
- Long pants are required for all activities; Wind pants work well for water activities
- No jewelry may be worn excepting for a watch and a wedding band
- All men should shave daily if required
- Shirttails must be tucked in at all times
- Only 1 button should be unbuttoned on a polo shirt
- A dress shirt and tie are required for Sunday services
